Scappoose Fire has a unique career opportunity for Paramedics and EMT's that want more than just providing patient care out of an ambulance. We offer experiences that can only be offered in an environment that has been cultivated by years of training, experience and the desire to go beyond the norms.

Our Emergency Response Technicians specialize in emergency medical care, but also serve as Wild Land Firefighters (FFT2), and have the ability to specialize as Rope Rescue Technicians (RRT) and Pilots of Uncrewed Aircraft (UASP). Our staff responds locally and regionally when requested.

Work Schedule

Our Emergency Response Technicians (ERT), Paramedic and EMT fill two opposite shifts. These shifts work a four on duty and four off duty rotation. Shifts start at 0800 and end at 2000.

The beginning of every shift comprises of daily checks and station duties. ERTs staff one of three ambulances and are trained and ready for wildfire responses and Special Operations assignments.

ERTs also participate in Non, Immediately Dangerous To Life and Health (IDLH) Fire activities.

When not responding on calls, ERTs are an integral component of daily and monthly training. Training includes Special Operations, EMS and Non IDLH fire activities.

Scappoose Fire is a combination fire agency that operates with 26 paid staff, 14 volunteers and covers an ambulance service area of 100 square miles. We border Portland Fire and TVF&R response areas. We operate out of four fire stations, one of which is the boat house. In 2021 we responded to 2,155 calls for service.



Rope Rescue

All ERTs have the ability to be trained and certified as Rope Rescue Technicians. We provide all the training materials, equipment and overtime.

Wildland Firefighting

All ERT's are required to be NWCG woodland FFT2 certified. This allows the ERTs to participate in local, regional and out of state responses.

REMS

All ERTs will be trained to support and operate in our Rapid Extraction Module Support platform. This responds locally, regionally and out of state.

UASP

All ERTs have the opportunity to train and be licensed as FAA Uncrewed Aircraft System Pilots (UASP). Our aircraft respond statewide.



Benefits

Our ERT's participate in Police / Fire PERS, we provide a 457 differed compensation match, up to 5% (after one year), medical, dental and vision for families, VEBA (\$500-1,000 a month), life insurance, holiday, vacation and comp time. We also offer additional incentive pay (above posted salary) for advanced certifications.

Scappoose Fire maintains the certification costs for all employees, has significant educational opportunities for staff above and beyond what is mentioned here.
